COVID-19 UPDATE INFORMATION—IMPORTANT

The latest COVID restrictions for the Department of Education can be found at: https://education.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/advice-for-families

Please note that only "essential visitors" are still allowed on the school site at this stage.

Parents and volunteers for scheduled educational support roles for activities that are essential to the delivery of the curriculum are permitted on site and will be managed by individual classroom teachers, ensuring physical distancing for all adults is maintained. All essential visitors to the site must first attend the office to sign in and complete an 'Essential Visitors to School Site Form'.

As COVID-19 continues to impact on the wider community and on schools, I have attached an excerpt from the Department of Education's Advice for Families page regarding updates to student and staff safety measures. Please be aware of the following changes / continuation of practices regarding school operations at MHPS.

Students should be at school unless:

- They have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected timeframe.
- They are currently unwell. In accordance with advice from NSW Health, parents and carers are reminded NOT to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms. Schools will make arrangements for students who present as unwell or have flu-like symptoms to be sent home.

Students and staff with flu like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school.

Also a reminder that parents/carers are not to be on site except for special circumstances. If you are bringing your child late to school, or need to take your child early from school, please phone the office to organise the collection of your child at the school gate.

PRESENTATION DAYS

Dear Parents,

As mentioned previously, this year's Presentation Day will be held differently to other years to comply with our COVID-19 Safety Plan.

It is a requirement that we comply with the 4 square metre rule for all people participating (this includes staff and students) before we are able to invite parents, carers or special guests.

Unfortunately due to the size of our Hall and COLA assembly areas, we will be unable to allow parent or community participation nor special guests this year.

As there is typically high parent engagement in our Presentation Day, the school has purchased USB flash drives and will be recording the Infants and Primary Presentation Day ceremonies. All students who receive an award on the day will receive a copy of the filmed event.

This event will not be live streamed as we have multiple students who do not have permission to publish. These students' names and images will not appear on the published recording that each award recipient receives. Regards,

ETHIC TEACHER/COORDINATOR

Could you be an ethics teacher or coordinator?

The Primary Ethics program is run at the school by volunteers. We are seeking a few more volunteers so that we can continue to provide ethics classes for all the families who have requested it for their children for 2021.

You don't need any teaching experience to be an ethics teacher - full training and lesson materials are provided by Primary Ethics (the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the program). Children discuss topics such as: imagining how others feel, how do we treat living things and fairness. Training consists of a two-day workshop and short online modules. Ethics is run on Wednesdays each week from 2:25-3:25pm.

We are also looking for someone to take over the coordination role for the ethics program. This role has more flexibility — requiring approximately 1-2 hours/week. The ethics coordinator communicates with school staff, supports ethics teachers and liaises with Primary Ethics (online training about what is required is provided).


