STUDENTS RETURN COVID-19 SAFE

The NSW Department of Education has worked closely with NSW Health to develop a framework for COVID-19 response settings for schools. All regional schools are operating on Level 2.

Key points relating to MHPS:

- Students should not attend school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms must be sent home and not return to school unless they have isolated for 10 days when no medical certificate is available or if they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient.
- Non-essential visitors are not permitted on school grounds. Parents and carers are asked to please drop children off at the gates each morning and wait outside school grounds of an afternoon, remembering to socially distance.
- Students arriving late or being collected early.
 Please phone the school to arrange collection of your child at the top school gate.
- All essential visitors and school staff must sign in using the Service NSW QR code.
- At this stage all excursions and incursions are on hold. We will need to see how the COVID restrictions proceed over the coming weeks. We will keep you informed what this will look like as early as we are able to do so.
- All community events within school hours are on hold.
- School sport can resume on school grounds only with minimal mingling of student groups.
- School orientation programs are permitted with COVID-safe practices in place.

The staff will continue to review the restrictions and work with all community members to ensure the ongoing safety of our students.
